Then back to Myoko, stopping at both the Shin-Akakura and Akakura areas.

**The One-Day Tour is conducted every Wednesday and Sunday**, provided four or more persons have reserved. Reservations are for two or more.

**Reservation Deadline:** two days prior to the tour. Please make your reservations through your hotel, to the Myoko Tourist Office.

**Tour fee:** ¥10,000 per person (primary school age to adults); children not requiring lunch ¥5,000; infants and toddlers free. Big 4 Passes can be used at a value of ¥4,000 each; please pay the balance in cash.
